BY-LAWS
ARTICLE I
Dues

Section 1. General Membership

General membership in the ANRS and Rodeo Exes shall consist of payment of dues determined by Sul Ross State University Alumni Affairs with approval by a majority vote of the Executive Board.

Section 2. Special Memberships

The Sul Ross State University Alumni Affairs may offer special rates for various kinds of special memberships in the ANRS and Rodeo Exes. The same charge will be assessed to both individual and husband-wife memberships, provided both are former students of Sul Ross State University.

ARTICLE II
Duties of Officers

Section 1. President

The duties of the President shall be:

- A. Preside at all the meetings of the Executive Board/Executive Committee.
- B. Perform such duties as prescribed in the Constitution.
- C. In coordination with the Executive Committee, shall appoint from the membership of the Association such committees as may be required.

Section 2. Vice-President

The duties of the Vice-President shall be:

- A. Perform the duties of the President in his/her absence at the Annual Summer Board Meeting and Official Meetings of the Executive Committee.
- B. Perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Executive Committee.

Section 3. Secretary

The duties of the Secretary shall be:

- A. Perform such duties as the Executive Committee may determine.
- B. Keep all records and proceedings of the Association.
- C. Provide Archives of the Big Bend with a copy of all records and proceedings that need to be available in perpetuity (constitution, officers, newsletters).
- D. Act as editorial coordinator of all publicity for the Association.
- E. Be responsible for conducting the Association elections.

Section 4. Treasurer

The duties of the Treasurer shall be:

- A. Under the supervision of the Executive Committee, have charge of the books and accounts of the ANRS and Rodeo Exes Association.
- B. Be responsible for the receipt, disbursement, and proper acknowledgement of all moneys for adequate accounting.
- C. Be an Ex-officio member of all scholarship committees.
- D. Perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Executive Committee.

Section 5. Executive Board

The duties of the Executive Board shall be:

- A. Serve as the governing body of the Association.
- B. Be responsible for management, programs, policies, and general operation of the Association.
- C. The Executive Committee shall be responsible for advising the Executive Board, as appropriate.

Section 6. Removal from Office

Officers and Directors who do not attend meetings or participate in preparations for the annual reunion and roping may be removed from office and replaced by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE III

Exes Reunion and/or Roping

Section 1. Eligibility

In order to compete in the ANRS and Rodeo Exes annual Exes Roping, a competitor must be a graduate of Sul Ross State University and a member of the Association.

Section 2. Blacklisting

Any member may be suspended from competing, participating in reunion activities by a unanimous vote of the Executive Board.

Section 3. Changes in Exes Roping

Any changes to the Exes Roping shall be brought to the Board through a recommendation from any officer or director or by petition signed by 10 members in good standing of the association. Changes will then be approved by a simple majority vote of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE IV

Amendments

The By-Laws may be amended by a simple majority vote of the Executive Board, provided notice of such proposed amendment and notification of such meeting, has been mailed to each member of the Executive Board at least twenty days prior to the meeting.
